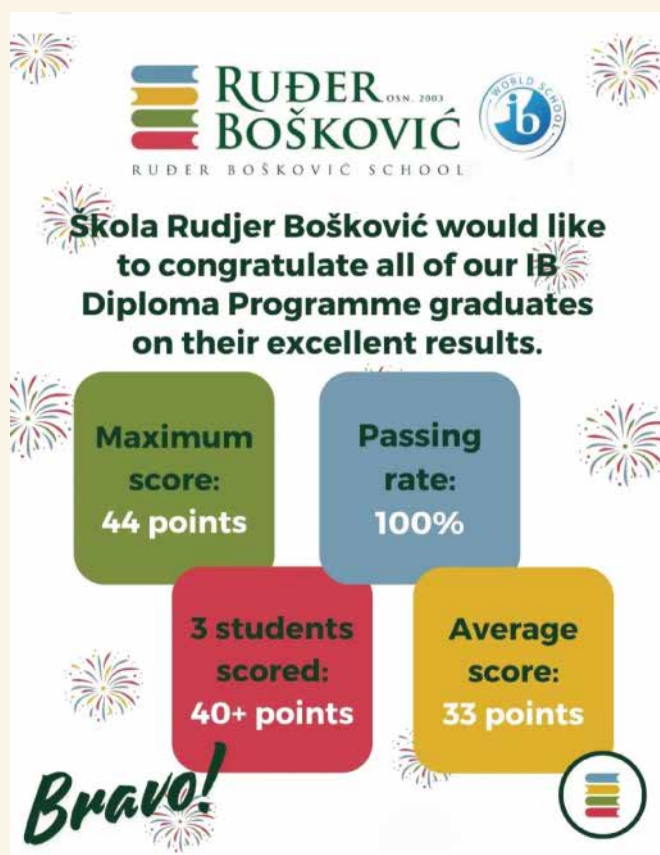


Looking Ahead to 1st September
