## INTENSIVE ENGLISH COURSE FOR BEGINNERS

Every day from Monday to Thursday, between 15:00 and 15:45, the school organises an intensive English course for beginners. The course is designed for students who need to improve their language skills quickly in order to follow the lessons effectively and engage fully in class activities.

Taught by our English teachers, the course uses small groups to adapt lessons to individual needs and support faster progress. Through consistent practice, students develop the essential skills needed to understand and speak English, gain confidence in communication, and build a solid foundation for further learning.

## SPORTS

Sports club: According to the suggestions of the profession, we are not allowed contact sports in this period (football, basketball, handball, etc.), but volleyball certainly is because it does not include defense and play on the net too much, so students will keep their distance.

Badminton, mini tennis, table tennis and certain other sports activities such as: hot and time balls, invasion-conquest games will be available, and we have planned several more interesting games such as dice with a foot and dice with a hand in already drawn fields. We will also try to organize some group trainings, to animate a larger group through ZUMBA and AEROBICS and if that proves to be an interesting solution, we will offer some other forms of training such as: pilates (girls), crossfit (boys).

We will try to bring in athletes-demonstrators who will explain the essence of the sport from their aspect. The main goal is to achieve proper biopsychosocial development of children and create a habit of engaging in physical activity. We are looking forward to hanging out with you, progressing together and achieving great results through the game!



## ART

Art is for the students who want to get to know different artistic-visual expression techniques and who like to use the imagination when they express the world around them. At these classes, students will have the opportunity and freedom to express creativity and originality by drawing, painting, transforming or merging different materials, but also in other ways, in accordance with the age and individual characteristics.

## DANCE

Students will develop strength and flexibility through basic exercises. They will get to know the basics of contemporary dance and they will have the opportunity to show their creativity and dance expression through choreography.



## ORIENTEERING

This school year students will have the opportunity to get acquainted with orienteering as well. Orienteering is a sport and a skill of navigating in nature with the help of a map and a compass. Our activities in these classes will be organized with the great help and support of the Orienteering Association of Serbia. We will learn to use a compass and a map and we will spend a lot of time in the field, in outdoor classes. We will organize lectures, orienteering through Belgrade, but also competitions in this sport.

## DEBATE CLUB – A NEW EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY FOR MYP STUDENTS

This year, our school has launched a new activity – the Debate Club – aimed at students in the upper grades of primary school. The club gives students the opportunity to develop critical thinking, argumentation, and public speaking skills through engaging discussions and debates on topics relevant to their age and interests. By participating in the Debate Club, students learn how to shape their own opinions, listen to others, and exchange ideas constructively while respecting different perspectives. These activities not only support their academic development but also foster self-confidence, teamwork, and a culture of dialogue.

The Debate Club is open to all curious students who want to express their ideas, learn how to develop strong arguments, and take part in this exciting form of knowledge and idea-based competition.
