Teacher Professional Development

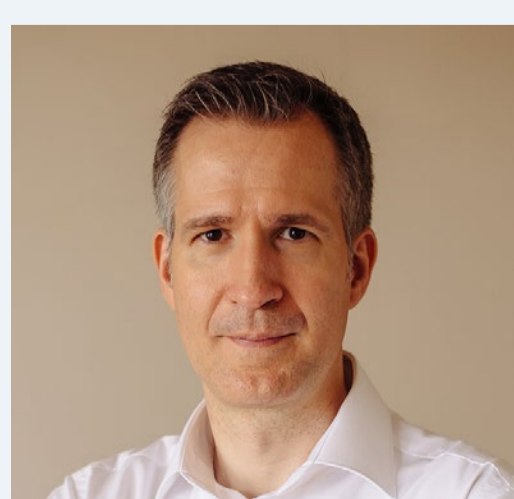


Our School's English Language Teachers at the International ELTA Conference

Our English language teachers recently took part in the annual international ELTA conference, held on 15 and 16 May at the Faculty of Education in Belgrade. This prominent professional gathering brought together a large number of language educators, and specialists in English language teaching from across Serbia and abroad, offering a valuable opportunity to exchange experiences, explore contemporary teaching practices, and expand professional knowledge.

In keeping with the principles of the IB MYP programme, which encourages lifelong learning and the ongoing professional development of all members of the school community, attending the conference proved to be a meaningful step forward in enhancing classroom practice.
